

New Year's Resolution

"I have chosen to be faithful; I have determined to live by your laws" (Psalm 119:30).

The term "resolution" (as we often think of it) basically means "firm determination to take a course of action." With each new-year people all around the

nation make their new year's resolutions. With some it is to quit smoking; with others it's to go on a diet or

to get more exercise (etc.). Though intentions are usually very good, for many it seems that their determination loses steam in just a short while.
