The Fatherhood of God

The Proud Father

The father was just gushing over his son. He had become incredibly successful in business, having become a millionaire in less than 10 years. “It is a tribute to his drive and hard work!” he said. “He knows what he wanted in life and went after it!”

The tenor of the conversation took a negative turn when I asked, “How is he doing spiritually?” The father’s head bowed and his voice softened. “Not so good,” he said. “He never goes to church anymore. He is too busy spending all that money he’s made.”

I am proud of my boys. They have become good men; good workers and good fathers. But the reason I’m most pleased in them is that they have become “righteous” men. It is clear that their priorities are in the right place. God is first in their lives. They are church leaders. They are diligent Bible students. They provide spiritual direction for their children. They’re never going to be millionaires, and I’m ok with that.

Solomon’s words are not directed to fathers. He had given them wise directives earlier (22:6). This proverb is actually for the son. He needs to give consideration on how his life-choices are going to impact his father (and mother – in the next verse). The child needs to recognize the investment his parents made in him, from giving birth to the years of discipline, instruction and training. Apparently, this approach works, or else it wouldn’t be in God’s word! Most of us remember well how badly we wanted to please our parents.

God laid down the principle when He said at Mount Sinai: “Honor your father and your mother” (Exodus 20:12). So, sons and daughters – are your parents happy because you have become righteous
