Sheep Don't Wallow

The story is told of a lamb and its mother. It seems the lamb passed a pig pen each morning on the way to pasture with its mother. Watching the pigs wallow in the mud seemed like fun and on an especially hot day the lamb asked his mother if he could jump the fence and wallow in the cool mud. She replied, "NO". Then the lamb asked the usual question, "WHY?" The mother just said, "SHEEP DON'T WALLOW."
